Luke 10:25-37



1. An Important question - how can I gain eternal life?

- Dishonest question test Jesus
- What must I DO?
 - Love God
 - Love your neighbour
- Lingering question has this man really met the requirements of the law?



2. Wrong - follow up question...

- Should have asked how can anyone find eternal life IF they have FAILED to love God and their neighbour perfectly.
- This man wanted to justify himself
 - Right with God on his own merit
 - He wants to lower God's standards



3. The Story - a good Samaritan

- Shocking Story
- Man beaten
- Two religious men pass by
- Jews and Samaritans hate each other
- Samaritan takes:
 - Pity
 - Lavishes kindness
 - At great cost to Himself



3. The Story - a good Samaritan

- Who is the neighbour?
 - Go and do likewise

Unasked question - have you done this?

- Ready to admit you can't earn eternal life
- Wider Context
 - 10:22 Salvation revealed
 - 10:25-37 You can't earn it
 - 10:38-42 One thing is needed Jesus



Unasked question - have you done this?

 The only person who have ever perfectly loved like the Samaritan is Jesus

Jesus is the real good Samaritan

Seen in how He loved us.



4. True Love

- Heart transformed by Jesus will be moved to love others
- Heart that love to earn salvation is not not loving genuinely
 - fake love
 - Defines who is worthy of my love
 - will be judgemental
 - will impose limits
 - will be proud
 - Check out the Pharisees!



4. True Love

- A heart transformed
- love flows from a love shown to them
- LOVE is NOT...
 - Limited in who they love
 - It disregards race, politics, class and religion
 - limited by time
 - it gives as is necessary
 - judgemental
 - it recognises but for the grace of God
 - limited in what it does
 - It gives at great cost



4. True Love

- How will you move towards?
 - How might you greet?
 - Who might you greet?
 - How might you engage in a thoughtful conversation with them?
 - Are you looking for the good in them?
 - How might you serve them?
